<p>APPLICATION DEADLINES</p>	<p>Semester beginning in September : June 1st Semester beginning in January : October 30th</p>
<p>DOCUMENTS REQUIRED</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Cover letter -CV/Résumé -Official records transcript
<p>HOW TO SEND THE APPLICATION</p>	<p>The partner university has to send the student's application to the administrative coordinator by email</p>
<p>NUMBER OF OPENINGS</p>	<p>5 students per term</p>



ACADEMIC INFORMATION

<p>NUMBER OF CREDITS PER SEMESTER</p>	<p>The number of credits per semester in the EPP is 30.</p> <p>However the exchange students are not compelled to obtain the full 30 credits: they may choose their classes according to the requirements of their university of origin. The number of credits indicated stands for the whole year (a 6 credit class means you will obtain 3 credits in case you attend it for one semester only). Credits are ECTS (European Credit s Transfer Scale), based on hours of attended classes, homework and objec-</p>
<p>LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION</p>	<p>The classes are taught in French. Exchange students do not need to submit proof of their proficiency in French. However it is their responsibility to make sure they are able to take their classes.</p>
<p>GRADING</p>	<p>The students' results are graded using numbers from 0 to 20. 0 being the worst grade and 20 the best one. A student passes the examination if his/her final grade is equal or superior to 10.</p>
<p>ATTENDING CLASSES REQUIREMENT</p>	<p>In order to pass the examination, the students must attend all the classes. They may have up to three unexcused absences, but they will fail the class if they have more.</p>



FURTHER INFORMATION ABOUT STUDYING IN FRANCE

<p>VISA</p>	<p>Every non-European student willing to study in France has to get a visa called “Visa de long séjour pour études”.</p>
<p>OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE FORMALITIES UPON ARRIVAL</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health Insurance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - European students have to get the European Health Insurance Card -Non-European students have to get the French student’s health insurance if they stay more than 3 months in France -Students from Québec must get the SE401-Q-102 bis (ou SE 01-Q-106) form (health insurance certificate) • Visa validation <p>Non-European students have to go to the French Office for Immigration and Integration (OFII), in order to get the visa confirmed (fees : 60 euros).</p>
